## THE PROCESS

k Edit

- First used magnetic lasso to cut out the model from the background.
- Googled "hood background" and placed the model on top of it
- Googled "black and white tattoo" and used the lasso tool to draw around it.
- Cut Audrey's eye and eyebrow out and set it aside.
- Used free transform and placed the tattoo on her face.
- Used eyedropper tool and collected color of her skin. Used opacity of 18% and colored over the tattoo to tone down its darkness and make it look more realistic.
- Placed her eye and eyebrow back over the tattoo and used the background eraser tool to blend it together
- Googled "tongue piercing". Used magnetic lasso, copy and pasted it onto the face using 10x feathering. Changed hue/saturation to make the mouth and tongue purple.
- Used background eraser tool to get rid of her body and hair.
- Googled "purple mohawk" and used magnetic lasso to copy and paste. Used clone stamp tool to color in bald spots and shape the face.
- Then googled picture of a gauge earring. Used magnetic lasso with 10x feathering. Used auto contrast and auto tone.
- Googled "black and white tattooed body" used magnetic lasso and copy and pasted body. Then used eyedropper stamp and background eraser to blend in the body.

### Alien Edit

- Used magnetic lasso to cut the figure away from the background.
- Found "space background" online, set as the background.
- Used green, paint tool with 60% opacity to color her face.
- Using the liquifying tool, I pulled up the eyebrow, stretched out the nose, and pulled at her smile lines giving her a creepy smile. Then I pulled at the top of her head, creating antennae's.
- I then googled "American Flag" and "astronaut". Used the magnetic lasso on both of them and placed the pieces into the background. I then used the rectangle marquee tool to create a flag pole and colored it gray.
- Used background eraser tool to erase body, hair, and ear.
- Googled "Halloween alien costumes" and once again used the magnetic marquee tool to cut out the top half of the image. Used free transform to flip it horizontally to fit the way her body is standing.
- The played with the hue/saturation to make the body green.
- Selecting just the outfit, I used hue/saturation again to make the outfit yellow to stand out.
- I then used the eyedropper tool to collect the green skin color and create a neck.
- I found "orange hair" online, used lasso tool to cut multiple sections of hair to make it look as realistic as possible.
- Then used the clone stamp tool to run through the hair and try to blend it.
- Using the same orange color, I drew overtop of the eyebrow.

### Glamorous Edit

- First used the magnetic lasso tool to cut out the figure from the white background.
- Googled "glitter", saved a picture and made it the background
- Googled "tiara", used the magnetic lasso tool to cut it out with 10x feathering, and placed it onto her head. Also used the outer glow effect and drop shadow.
- Googled "eye makeup", used the rectangle marquee tool and 10x feather
- Used eyedropper tool to collect color of skin tone from around the eye used, colors the face using the paint brush with 29% opacity and flow 50%.
- Went in with a more orange toned skin color to bronze her face.
- Using a red color, 29% opacity, 50% flow to color lips.
- Used eyedropper tool on the eyebrow to continue to draw the rest of her brow.
- Found "diamond earring" and "diamond necklace" online, used magnetic lasso on both before dragging them onto the picture, used luminosity and inner glow effect on the necklace.
- Used eyedropper tool to obtain skin color again, free-handed a body shape.
- Used black paint with 30% opacity to define body
- Found "formal dress" online, used the magnetic tool with 5x feathering before placing the dress onto the body.
